

# SENATE . . . . No. 270

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To accompany the petition of William P. McDermott and others' board of public welfare of the town of Mansfield, for legislation relative to the records of persons performing labor or other services in return for aid granted by or through local boards of public welfare. Public Welfare.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

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An Act relative to the Records of Persons performing Labor or Other Services in Return for Aid granted by or through Local Boards of Public Welfare.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section thirty-four of chapter forty-  
2 one of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercen-  
3 tenary edition thereof, is hereby amended by adding  
4 at the end the following: —

5 The name of any person who is aided by or through  
6 a board of public welfare and in return for such aid  
7 performs labor or other services, shall not be considered  
8 a matter of public record in the office of the board of  
9 public welfare and shall not be open to inspection under  
10 the provisions of section ten of chapter sixty-six.

1 SECTION 2. Section thirty-three of chapter one  
2 hundred and seventeen of the General Laws, as so

3 appearing, is hereby amended by adding at the end  
4 thereof the following:—

5 The name of any person who is aided by or through  
6 a board of public welfare and in return for such aid  
7 performs labor or other services shall not be included  
8 in this return.

1 SECTION 3. Section thirty-two of said chapter one  
2 hundred and seventeen is hereby repealed.
