An Act to approve, confirm and ratify Certain Acts of the County Commissioners and County Treasurer of Bristol County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The acts of the county commissioners of Bristol
2 county in taking in fee the land of one John H.
3 Seaman in New Bedford in said county under
4 order of taking dated June nineteen, nineteen hun-
5 dred and thirty-four, office of the county commis-
6 sioners of Bristol county, for the purpose of alter-
7 ing or adding to the superior court house land or
8 buildings in the city of New Bedford or for any
9 other legal purpose and their approval of the pay-
10 ment to said John H. Seaman of the sum of ten
11 thousand dollars in full and complete settlement
12 and payment of damages for the said taking and
13 the acts of the county treasurer of Bristol county
14 in paying to said Seaman the sum of ten thousand

15 dollars in full and complete settlement for the
 16 taking of said land by said county commissioners
 17 and the settlement of all land damages in connec-
 18 tion with said taking, are approved, confirmed and
 19 ratified.
