## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

### An Act regulating the Operation of Rapid Transit Trains.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
3 after section ninety-one the following new sec-  
4 tion: —

5 *Section 91A.* Every company shall during the  
6 operation by it of any train consisting of more  
7 than one car, cause to be stationed thereon one  
8 guard, brakeman, or other employee having simi-  
9 lar duties, for at least every two cars of such  
10 train. For each violation of this section the  
11 offending company shall forfeit to the common-  
12 wealth the sum of five hundred dollars.
