

SENATE No. 297

To accompany the petition of Laurie Ebacher that provision be made for a referendum to the voters of the town of Amesbury on the question of establishing a municipal lighting plant in said town. Power and Light.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act providing for a Referendum to the Voters of the Town of Amesbury on the Question of establishing a Municipal Lighting Plant in Said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the
2 voters of the town of Amesbury at the current an-
3 nual town meeting the following question: — “Shall
4 the town purchase the plant of the Amesbury Elec-
5 tric Light Company for the purposes of furnishing
6 light and power for residential, industrial and munici-
7 pal purposes or if such purchase is found inadvisable,
8 construct such a plant, the same in either case to
9 be financed by an issue of bonds, with or without
10 federal aid?” The vote shall be taken by ballot
11 with the use of the voting list, and a favorable ma-
12 jority vote shall have the same effect as a favorable
13 vote at two successive town meetings taken under

14 section thirty-six of chapter one hundred and sixty-
15 four of the General Laws, as appearing in the Ter-
16 centenary edition.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
