## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

---

An Act establishing the Salary of the District Attorney for the Northwestern District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section fifteen of chapter twelve of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary edition,  
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in the tenth  
4 line, the word "three" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the word:— five, — so as to read as  
6 follows:— *Section 15.* District attorneys shall  
7 receive from the commonwealth salaries as fol-  
8 lows:—

9 For the Suffolk district, nine thousand dollars.

10 For the northern district, seven thousand dol-  
11 lars.

12 For the eastern district, six thousand dollars.

13 For the middle district, six thousand dollars.

14 For the southeastern district, six thousand  
15 dollars.

16 For the southern district, five thousand dollars.

17 For the western district, four thousand dollars.

18 For the northwestern district, five thousand  
19 dollars.
