

SENATE No. 396

To accompany the petition of Henry D. Miller that provision be made for the payment of a pension or other compensation to Joseph Murphy who was injured while in the performance of duty as a member of the State Police. Joint Ways and Means.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act providing for a Pension for Joseph Murphy of Holyoke, a Member of the State Police who was seriously injured.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be paid to Joseph Murphy of Hol-
2 yoke, who was injured while in the performance
3 of his duties as a member of the state police in
4 March, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, an
5 annual pension equal to one-half the salary he
6 was receiving at the time of said injury. Said
7 pension shall be payable monthly.
