Resolve in Favor of Joseph Murphy of Holyoke.

1 *Resolved*, That, after an appropriation has been
2 made, there be allowed and paid out of the treas-
3 ury of the commonwealth to Joseph Murphy of
4 Holyoke, the sum of five hundred and forty-six
5 dollars, for medical expenses incurred by him as
6 a result of injuries sustained by him while in the
7 performance of his duties in March, nineteen
8 hundred and thirty-one, as a member of the state
9 police.
