## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

---

An Act further regulating the Use by Public Service Corporations of their Revenues received from the Rendition of Public Service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and fifty-five of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
3 after section three A, as appearing in the Ter-  
4 centenary edition, the following new section:—  
5 *Section 3B.* Except with the consent and  
6 approval of the department first had and ob-  
7 tained, no public service corporation shall use  
8 revenues received from the rendition of public  
9 service within the commonwealth for any pur-  
10 pose other than its operating, maintenance and  
11 depreciation expenses, the construction, exten-  
12 sion, improvement or maintenance of its facili-  
13 ties and service, the payment of its indebted-  
14 ness and interest thereon, and the payment of  
15 dividends to its stockholders.
