## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act dispensing with Educational Requirements as a Condition of Taking Certain Civil Service Examinations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter thirty-one of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section six, as most re-  
3 cently amended by chapter two hundred and sixty  
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-two, the  
5 following new section:—

6 *Section 6A.* No rule or regulation shall be made  
7 setting up educational requirements as a condition  
8 of taking a civil service examination except in respect  
9 to professional and other positions for which such  
10 requirements are expressly imposed by statute.
