Proposal for a Legislative Amendment to the Constitution providing for the Compulsory Retirement of Judicial Officers at the Age of Seventy.

1 A joint session of the senate and house of repre-
2 sentatives hereby declares it to be expedient to alter
3 the constitution by the adoption of the following
4 article of amendment, to the end that it may become
5 a part of the constitution, if similarly agreed to in a
6 joint session of the next general court and approved
7 by the people at the state election next following: —

8 ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

9 Article I of chapter III of Part the Second of the
10 constitution is hereby amended by striking out the
11 words added thereto by Article LVIII of the amend-
12 ments to the constitution and substituting therefor
13 the following: — and provided also that they shall
14 retire at the age of seventy, and further that the
15 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
16 may after due notice and hearing retire them because
17 of mental or physical disability. Retirement because
18 of age or disability as aforesaid shall be subject to
19 such provisions of law relative to pensions and retire-
20 ment allowances as may be enacted.
