An Act repealing the Law eliminating Compulsory Motor Vehicle Insurance for the Benefit of Guests of Persons whose Liability is Covered Thereby.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter four hundred and fifty-nine of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and thirty-five, being an amend-
3 ment to section thirty-four A of chapter ninety of
4 the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
5 Edition, is hereby repealed.
