## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

An Act reducing the Time in which Mandatory Minimum Wage Orders may be Issued.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would  
2 tend to defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby  
3 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
4 immediate preservation of the public welfare.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and fifty-one of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by chapter three hundred and eight  
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-four, is  
4 hereby further amended by striking out, in section  
5 thirteen, line two, the words "nine months", and  
6 inserting in place thereof the words: — two months.
