

HOUSE No. 1116

By Messrs. Savage and Welsh of Boston, petition of Patrick J. Welsh and Charles H. Savage for legislation to authorize appointment of an additional court officer for the municipal court of the West Roxbury district of the city of Boston. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act providing for an Additional Court Officer in the Municipal Court of the West Roxbury District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section sixty-two of chapter two hundred and
2 eighteen of the General Laws, as appearing in the
3 Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by insert-
4 ing after the word "appointed" in the seventh line
5 the words:—; in the municipal court of the West
6 Roxbury district three court officers may be ap-
7 pointed,— by inserting after the word "district"
8 the first time it appears in the ninth line the word:—
9 and,— and by striking out, in the same line, the
10 words "and of the West Roxbury district",— so as
11 to read as follows:— *Section 62.* In the municipal
12 court of the city of Boston the court officers appointed
13 shall not exceed ten for criminal business and five for
14 civil business and one of such court officers for crimi-
15 nal business shall be designated by the chief justice

16 as chief court officer of said court for criminal busi-
17 ness, and one of such court officers for criminal busi-
18 ness shall be designated as an assistant chief court
19 officer; in the municipal court of the Roxbury dis-
20 trict four court officers may be appointed; in the
21 municipal court of the West Roxbury district three
22 court officers may be appointed; in the municipal
23 court of the South Boston district, of the Charles-
24 town district and of the Dorchester district, the
25 East Boston district court, the district court of Chel-
26 sea, the third district court of eastern Middlesex and
27 the district court of East Norfolk two court officers
28 for each court may be appointed; and in each of the
29 other district courts in the commonwealth one court
30 officer may be appointed.
