An Act establishing a Maximum Rate for Local Taxes on Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-three of chapter fifty-nine of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following:—

5 No tax rate fixed hereunder, upon any real estate,
6 shall be in excess of thirty dollars per thousand of
7 valuation, such valuation to be limited to the fair
8 cash value of such property at the time of the assess-
9 ment.
