By Mr. Swain of Nantucket, petition of William T. Swain for legislation to provide that shucked scallops and quahaugs in the shell be sold by weight only. Conservation.

An Act requiring that Shucked Scallops and Quahaugs
in the Shell be sold only by Weight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety-four of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section eighty-eight A the
3 following new section:—

4 *Section 88B.* No shucked scallops and quahaugs in
5 the shell shall be sold except by weight.
