An Act providing for Dredging and Improving the Saugus and Pine Rivers in the Town of Saugus.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
- 2 to dredge the Saugus and Pine rivers to a depth of
- 3 twenty-two feet at low water and otherwise improve
- 4 the Saugus and Pine rivers from the ocean to Saugus
- 5 and Revere.
