An Act extending the Provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law, So Called, to include Nurses in Public Employment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section sixty-nine, chapter one hundred and fifty-  
2 two of the General Laws, is hereby amended by add-  
3 ing, between the word "include" and the word "fore-  
4 men" in the twenty-first line the following word:—  
5 nurses.
