## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

---

An Act relative to the Inspection by the Department of Public Utilities of Motor Vehicles used for the Transportation of Passengers or Property for Hire.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section nine of chapter one hundred and fifty-nine B  
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
3 after the second paragraph the following:

4 The department may establish a section for the in-  
5 spection of motor vehicles used for the transportation  
6 of passengers and property for hire with reference to all  
7 police requirements, including equipment and weight  
8 of loads, and it may assign for service in said section  
9 such number of investigators and examiners ap-  
10 pointed as aforesaid as it may deem necessary.  
11 Said investigators and examiners, with respect to the  
12 enforcement of the laws relating to motor vehicles

13 for hire, shall have and exercise throughout the com-  
14 monwealth all the powers of constables, except the  
15 service of civil process, and of police officers, includ-  
16 ing the power to arrest any person who violates any  
17 provision of this chapter, and they may serve all  
18 processes lawfully issued by the courts and the de-  
19 partment in the exercise of its functions under this  
20 chapter.
