

ACTS, 1981. - Chaps. 81, 82, 83.

Chap. 81. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SHREWSBURY TOWN MEETING.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter five hundred and fifty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-three is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 553, as most recently amended by chapter 766 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by striking out section 7 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 7. Precinct Representation.- Each precinct shall be represented in the representative town meeting by elected representatives the number of which shall be the largest number divisible by three and which shall bear the same proportion to the total elected membership as the number of residents in the precinct bears to the total number of residents in the town as nearly as may be.

The number and size of precincts shall be such that the number of elected representatives shall not exceed two hundred and forty.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 82. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING SECURITY DEPOSITS FOR RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 15B of chapter 186 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 553 of the acts of 1978, is hereby further amended by adding the following clause:-

(9) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any lease, rental, occupancy or tenancy of one hundred days or less in duration which lease or rental is for a vacation or recreational purpose.
