By Mr. Coakley of Boston, petition of Daniel H. Coakley, Jr., that Soldiers Field Road Extension in the Brighton district of Boston be designated Leo M. Birmingham Parkway and that the Metropolitan District Commission erect a suitable tablet or marker bearing said designation. Metropolitan Affairs.

An Act designating Soldiers Field Road Extension, So Called, in the Brighton District of the City of Boston as the Leo M. Birmingham Parkway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The parkway in the Brighton district
2 of the city of Boston between Western avenue and
3 North Beacon street and now commonly known as
4 Soldiers Field Road extension shall be known and
5 designated as the Leo M. Birmingham parkway,
6 and a suitable tablet or marker bearing said designa-
7 tion shall be erected at each terminus of said park-
8 way by the metropolitan district commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
