Mr. Clampit of Springfield presented a petition of Henry Martens (Mayor) that the city of Springfield be authorized to operate certain of its motor vehicle trailers on the ways of said city and the towns of Agawam, Ludlow and Wilbraham. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act relative to the Operation of Certain Motor Vehicle Trailers owned by the City of Springfield on the Ways of Said City and Certain Adjoining Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Motor vehicle trailers owned by the
2 city of Springfield and having a carrying capacity of
3 more than one thousand pounds may be operated or
4 drawn on the ways of said city and the towns of
5 Agawam, Ludlow and Wilbraham, any provision of
6 section nineteen of chapter ninety of the General
7 Laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of this act shall take effect
2 July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, and shall
3 become inoperative July first, nineteen hundred and
4 thirty-seven.
