

ACTS, 1981. - Chaps. 136, 137.

TO INCREASE THE ANNUITY PAID TO WINFRED
J. KNOWLES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 306 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the word "two" and inserting in place thereof the word:- five.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

Chap. 136. AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTION OF THE
SPECIAL TOWN MEETING HELD IN NATICK ON
OCTOBER SEVENTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The acts and proceedings of the town of Natick at the special town meeting on October seventh, nineteen hundred and eighty relative to the providing for the salary of the tree warden and all acts and proceedings done in pursuance thereof, are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed as if such meeting were the annual town meeting.

Chap. 137. AN ACT AUTHORIZING POLICE OFFICERS OF
THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO EXERCISE POLICE
POWERS ON CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OF SAID
CITY OUTSIDE ITS CORPORATE LIMITS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, all police officers of the city of Worcester appointed in accordance with the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws shall have the authority to exercise police powers on certain property owned by said city of Worcester in the towns of Paxton, Leicester, Holden, Princeton, Rutland and Shrewsbury, known as: the Pine Hill reservoir, the Kettle Brook reservoirs, the Holden reservoirs, the Lynde Brook reservoir, the Kendall reservoir, the Quinapoxet reservoir, the Shrewsbury wells, Boynton park, the Shrewsbury pistol range, the Worcester municipal airport and its instrument landing system equipment and towers; provided, that no police officer shall be detailed to
