The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act prohibiting the Admission of Minors to Certain Premises where Alcoholic Beverages are sold.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in section two of chapter
3 three hundred and seventy-six of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and thirty-three, is hereby amended by
5 inserting after section thirty-four the following new
6 section:—

7 *Section 34A.* No hotel, restaurant or tavern li-
8 censee, himself or by his servant or agent, shall admit
9 a minor to that part of the premises of such licensee
10 where alcoholic beverages are sold or served unless
11 such minor is accompanied by a parent, guardian or
12 adult member of the family with whom such minor
13 is residing. Whoever violates this section shall be
14 punished by a fine of not more than two hundred
15 dollars or by imprisonment for not more than six
16 months, or both.
