An Act providing for the More Effective and More Just Enforcement of the Law authorizing Revocation and Suspension of Motor Vehicle Licenses and Registrations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety, section twenty-four, of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "conviction", in line sixty-one, the following: — The
4 registrar, upon receiving a report of a conviction of
5 operating a motor vehicle negligently so that the lives
6 and safety of the public might be endangered, if no
7 conviction of any other offence under this or the pre-
8 ceding section is reported at the same time, shall not
9 revoke the license of the person so convicted, but may
10 suspend such license for such period, not exceeding
11 sixty days, as the court recommends.
