By Mr. Luitwieler of Newton, petition of the Automobile Legal Association that the time be limited within which there may be collected an additional excise tax on sales of gasoline and other fuel for motor vehicles. Taxation.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act limiting the Time During Which there shall be Collected an Additional Excise Tax on Sales of Gasoline.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The time during which the additional excise tax of
2 one cent on each gallon of fuel, as defined in section
3 one of chapter sixty-four A of the General Laws, sold
4 in the commonwealth imposed by the provisions of
5 section four of chapter one hundred and twenty-two
6 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-one and by
7 chapter two hundred and forty-eight of the acts of
8 nineteen hundred and thirty-two, as amended by
9 chapter three hundred and thirty-six of the acts of
10 nineteen hundred and thirty-five and chapter three
11 hundred and ninety-eight of the acts of nineteen hun-
12 dred and thirty-six, shall expire on the thirty-first day
13 of December, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.
