An Act relative to the Tenure of Office of City and Town Treasurers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter forty-one of the General Laws, as appear-
- 2 ing in the Tercentenary Edition, as last amended
- 3 by chapter two hundred and forty-two of the acts
- 4 of nineteen hundred and thirty-six, is hereby further
- 5 amended by inserting the following new section:—
- 6 *Section 1B.* A city or town treasurer who has by
- 7 virtue of election or appointment served consecu-
- 8 tively six years in the office of treasurer shall there-
- 9 after hold office continuously during good behavior
- 10 unless incapacitated by physical or mental disability
- 11 from performing the duties of treasurer.
