The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

An Act relative to the Commitment of School Offenders to County Training School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter seventy-seven of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
3 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following:—

5 The cities of Boston, Chelsea and Revere and the
6 town of Winthrop shall pay to Middlesex county, for
7 the support of each child committed therefrom to
8 the training school of said county, two dollars and
9 fifty cents a week, and an additional sum for each
10 child sufficient to cover the actual cost of mainte-
11 nance. Reports of the conditions and progress of its
12 pupils in said school shall be sent each month to the
13 superintendents of schools of said cities and town.
