

ACTS, 1981. - Chaps. 214, 215, 216.

Chap. 214. AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROVALS OF NEW ISSUES OF SECURITIES BY GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANIES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 16 of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- If, when the department approves an issue of new stock, bonds or other securities by a gas or electric company, it determines that the fair structural value of the plant and of the land and the fair value of the nuclear fuel owned by such company is less than its outstanding stock and debt, it may prescribe such conditions and requirements as it deems best adapted to make good within a reasonable time the impairment of the capital stock; or before allowing an increase, it may require the capital stock to be reduced by a prescribed amount, not exceeding the amount of such impairment.

Chap. 215. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN RATES OF PILOTAGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 5 of chapter 103 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "thereof", in line 5, the words:- , except in district one, wherein each pilot or any person for him, shall pay to said commissioners two per cent of the amount thereof.

Chap. 216. AN ACT REGULATING VOTER REGISTRATION SESSIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 42B of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 172 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:- Said registrars or election commissioners shall approve such petitions within seven business days of receipt thereof; provided that said petition is in compliance with

the requirements as set forth herein.

Chap. 217. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO TEATICKET LIQUORS, INC.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws the licensing authority of the town of Falmouth is hereby authorized to grant to Teaticket Liquors, Inc., d/b/a George's Liquor Store a license under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except section seventeen.

Chap. 218. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO K.M.K. INC.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws the licensing authority of the town of Falmouth is hereby authorized to grant to K.M.K. Inc. d/b/a J. B. Liquors a license under the provisions of section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said license shall be subject to the provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight except section seventeen.
