## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

---

An Act abolishing Non-Partisan Municipal Elections in the City of Cambridge and providing for Partisan Municipal Primaries in Said City.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of sections forty-four A  
2 to forty-four G, inclusive, of chapter forty-three of  
3 the General Laws shall no longer apply to the city  
4 of Cambridge.

1 SECTION 2. Candidates to be voted for at city  
2 elections in said city shall be nominated in municipal  
3 primaries held in accordance with the provisions of  
4 sections twenty-three to forty, and fifty-six to sixty-  
5 four, of chapter fifty-three of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the  
3 city council of said city subject to the provisions of  
4 its charter.
