Resolve providing for an Investigation by a Special Commission relative to the Construction of a Double-Deck Highway in the City of Boston.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the  
3 president thereof, three members of the house of repre-  
4 sentatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, one  
5 person to be appointed by the governor and one person  
6 to be appointed by the mayor of the city of Boston,  
7 is hereby established for the purpose of investigating  
8 the advisability and feasibility of constructing a  
9 double-deck highway from a point at or near the junc-  
10 tion of the northern artery, so called, and Nashua  
11 street in the city of Boston, thence in a general easterly  
12 direction to Commercial street and along said Com-  
13 mercial street and Atlantic avenue to a point near the  
14 south station, so called, and thence to a point at or  
15 near the junction of Beacon street and Brookline  
16 avenue. Said commission shall report to the general

17 court the results of its investigation and its recom-  
18 mendations, if any, together with estimates of cost  
19 and drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recom-  
20 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the  
21 clerk of the house of representatives on or before the  
22 first Wednesday of December in the current year.  
23 For said purpose said commission may expend such  
24 sum, not exceeding five thousand dollars, as may  
25 hereafter be appropriated.
