

ACTS, 1981. - Chaps. 271, 272.

Section 32C. A city or town may purchase, receive, or take by eminent domain easements or other rights or interests in land adjacent to a public way for the purpose of erecting and maintaining snow fences, so-called, thereon; provided, however, that such snow fences shall not be erected prior to November first of each year and shall be removed by May first of the next ensuing year.

A taking of any interest in land by eminent domain under this section shall be deemed a taking for highway purposes under section five B of chapter seventy-nine.

Chap. 271. AN ACT RELATIVE TO NOTIFICATION OF CERTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE TO EMPLOYEES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 32B of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 6, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 730 of the acts of 1956, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 6. Each employee to whom this chapter applies shall furnish the treasurer of the governmental unit, in such form as he shall prescribe, such information as is necessary to enroll himself alone, or himself and his dependents, under the policy or policies of insurance.

Each employee shall receive a certificate or booklet from the insurance company, savings bank or non-profit hospital, medical, or other service corporation describing the coverage for which the employee has enrolled. The certificate or booklet shall be printed at the expense of such insurance company, savings bank or nonprofit hospital, medical, dental, or other service corporation which has issued the policy or policies of insurance, and shall be approved by the appropriate public authority prior to distribution.

Chap. 272. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PROCEDURES FOR ESTABLISHING PREMIUM RATES FOR DENTAL SERVICE BENEFIT PLANS.
