## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven.

Resolve relative to the Transfer of Certain Trust Funds for the Perpetual Care of Lots in Quabbin Park Cemetery in the Town of Ware.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of carrying out  
2 the provisions of chapter thirty-three of the resolves  
3 of nineteen hundred and thirty-six, the selectmen of  
4 any town, the officers of any cemetery corporation  
5 and the trustees or other officers of any church, or  
6 parish, ancient or private cemetery, shall, upon writ-  
7 ten request of the metropolitan district water supply  
8 commission or its successors, transfer to the metro-  
9 politan district water supply commission or its suc-  
10 cessors or to the state treasurer trust funds estab-  
11 lished for the benefit or care of any cemetery or lots  
12 therein which contained remains removed to Quabbin  
13 Park Cemetery in the town of Ware prior to the  
14 completion of said cemetery, notwithstanding any  
15 provisions of section nine of said chapter three hun-  
16 dred and twenty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred

17 and twenty-seven, or any provisions of chapter one  
18 hundred and fourteen of the General Laws of the  
19 commonwealth, Tercentenary Edition.

20 The state treasurer is authorized to accept such  
21 trust funds, and if in cash, shall be safely invested  
22 by him, or if in securities or savings bank deposits  
23 he may hold them in their original form, or upon the  
24 approval of the governor sell or convert them and  
25 re-invest the proceeds as provided by section thirty-  
26 eight of chapter twenty-nine of the General Laws.
