Resolve providing for an Investigation and Study by the State Board of Housing relative to the Problem of Housing.

1 *Resolved*, That the state board of housing shall
2 investigate and study the problem of housing and the
3 expediency and desirability of the establishment in
4 the commonwealth of a uniform compulsory code of
5 laws with relation to the general problems of health,
6 sanitation and construction relative to housing. Said
7 board shall include in its annual report to the general
8 court the results of its investigation and study here-
9 under and its recommendations, together with drafts
10 of legislation necessary to carry the same into effect.
