Resolve further Increasing the Scope of the Investigation to be made by the Special Commission on Taxation and Public Expenditures.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission on taxation
2 and public expenditures, established by chapter three
3 of the resolves of the current year to investigate and
4 study relative to the problems of taxation and of
5 public expenditures, shall, in carrying out its work,
6 consider the subject matter of the bill accompanying
7 a message of the governor to the general court, printed
8 as current house document numbered nineteen hun-
9 dred and fifty-one, relative to the establishment,
10 powers and duties of housing authorities in the com-
11 monwealth.
