Resolve further Increasing the Scope of the Investigation to be made by the Special Commission on Taxation and Public Expenditures.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission on taxation
2 and public expenditures, established by chapter three
3 of the resolves of the current year to investigate and
4 study relative to the problems of taxation and of
5 public expenditures, shall, in carrying out its work,
6 consider the subject matter of current senate docu-
7 ment numbered four hundred and thirty-nine, relative
8 to appropriations for the use of the department of
9 education.
