In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF DISTRICTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE LABOR SERVICE OF SAID DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eighteen A of chapter thirty-one of the
2 General Laws, inserted by section four of chapter
3 six hundred and twenty-seven of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and forty-one, is hereby amended by adding
5 at the end the following: — Districts so established
6 shall not be changed unless written notice of the
7 change, stating the reasons therefor, is sent to the
8 director at least six months prior to the effective
9 date of such change, — so as to read as follows: —
10 *Section 18A.* Persons certified to fill positions in
11 the labor service of the state department of public
12 works shall be certified according to districts, to be
13 established by the state department of public works.
14 Districts so established shall not be changed unless
15 written notice of the change is sent to the director
16 at least six months prior to the effective date of
17 such change.
