AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter fifteen of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section nine, as appearing
3 in the Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following section: —

5 *Section 9.* The board of library commissioners in
6 sections nine to eleven, inclusive, called the library
7 board, shall consist of five persons, residents of the
8 commonwealth, one of whom shall annually be ap-
9 pointed by the governor, with the advice and con-
10 sent of the council, for five years. The governor shall
11 designate the chairman of the library board.
