AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FILING OF WRITTEN ACCEPTANCES OF NOMINATION BY CANDIDATES WHOSE NAMES ARE NOT PRINTED ON THE PRIMARY BALLOT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter fifty-three of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section one of
3 chapter three hundred and thirty-four of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and forty-three, is hereby further
5 amended by inserting after the word "receives" in
6 the third line the words:— or has reason to believe
7 he has received.
