## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT EXTENDING TO VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II THE  
ADVANTAGES OF UNIVERSITY EXTENSION COURSES FREE  
OF CHARGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Any person who resided in Massachusetts for not  
2 less than one year immediately prior to his entry into  
3 the military or naval service of the United States  
4 shall, upon his discharge, other than a dishonorable  
5 one, after having served at least sixty days in such  
6 service, be entitled to take university extension  
7 courses, free of charge, for a period of four years  
8 from the date of said discharge.
