## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ANDOVER TO APPROPRIATE MONEY IN ADVANCE FOR THE CELEBRATION OF THE TERCENTENARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Andover may appropri-  
2 ate money in the year nineteen hundred and forty-  
3 five for the celebration, in the year nineteen hundred  
4 and forty-six, or in such later year to which said  
5 celebration may be postponed by said town, of the  
6 tercentenary of the founding of the town. Money so  
7 appropriated may be expended for said purpose in the  
8 years nineteen hundred and forty-five and nineteen  
9 hundred and forty-six, and in succeeding years up to  
10 and including the year in which said celebration  
11 occurs.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
