AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN
OF THE ACTS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND TEN RELATING
TO TRUST FUNDS OF THE TOWN OF LEXINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and seven, section five, of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and ten is amended by
3 adding at the end of the said section the following:—
4 The said board from time to time shall receive
5 from the cemetery commissioners of the town of
6 Lexington the perpetual care fund of Westview ceme-
7 tery and additions thereto, and shall invest and re-
8 invest the sums in such securities as they shall deem
9 safe and proper, having always in mind the security
10 of said principal sum, and shall pay over the net
11 income thereof to the town treasurer, who shall hold
12 it subject to appropriation by the town for the care,
13 improvement and embellishment of the Westview
14 cemetery.
