AN ACT PLACING UNDER CIVIL SERVICE CERTAIN EMPLOYEES AT INSTITUTIONS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENTS OF MENTAL HEALTH, PUBLIC HEALTH AND CORRECTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The position of chief engineer at institutions under  
2 the control of the department of mental health and  
3 the positions of all employees in the departments of  
4 said engineers and the positions of all employees who  
5 come under the direction of the maintenance foreman  
6 thereat, and the positions of all employees under the  
7 direction of the maintenance foreman and chief  
8 engineer at institutions under the control of the  
9 department of public health, and the positions of all  
10 employees who come under the direction of the chief  
11 engineer and the position of foreman and the positions  
12 of all employees who come under the direction of

13 such foreman in institutions under the control of the  
14 department of correction shall, upon the effective  
15 date of this act, become subject to the civil service  
16 laws and rules and regulations, and the tenure of  
17 office of the incumbents of said positions shall be  
18 unlimited, subject, however, to said laws, but the  
19 incumbents of said positions on said effective date  
20 may continue to serve as such without taking a civil  
21 service examination.
