AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE FOR A
NON-RESIDENT CITIZEN'S FUR BUYER'S LICENSE, SO
CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (2) of section one hundred and three of
2 chapter one hundred and thirty-one of the General
3 Laws, as appearing in section two of chapter five hun-
4 dred and ninety-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred
5 and forty-one, is hereby amended by striking out,
6 in the third line, the word "twenty-five" and inserting
7 in place thereof the words: — one hundred, — so as
8 to read as follows: — (2) A citizen of the United
9 States, non-resident in this commonwealth, a "Non-
10 Resident Citizen's Fur Buyer's License" upon pay-
11 ment of a fee of one hundred dollars.
