AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter twenty-three of the General Laws, as
2 amended by chapter three hundred and twenty-one
3 of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three, is
4 hereby further amended by striking out section two,
5 as amended, and inserting in place thereof the follow-
6 ing section:—

7 *Section 2.* Upon the expiration of the term of
8 office of a commissioner, an assistant commissioner or
9 an associate commissioner, his successor shall be
10 appointed for three years by the governor, with the
11 advice and consent of the council. The commissioner
12 shall receive such salary not exceeding nine thousand
13 dollars, and the assistant commissioner and the
14 associate commissioners such salaries, not exceeding
15 five thousand dollars each, as the governor and
16 council determine.
