

ACTS, 1981. - Chaps. 380, 381, 382.

Chap. 380. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SPENCER TO LEASE CERTAIN PROPERTY FOR A TERM OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The town of Spencer, acting by and through its board of selectmen, is hereby authorized to lease to the Spencer Agricultural Association for a term of twenty-five years the Spencer Fairgrounds, better known as Myrick Park, situated on Smithville road in the town of Spencer.

Chap. 381. AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE FOR JOHN J. McKENNA, JR., INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. John J. McKenna, Jr., incumbent in the office of executive secretary of the traffic commission of the city of New Bedford, shall hold said office during good behavior until he attains the age of seventy years, unless incapacitated by physical or mental disability from performing the duties thereof, but he may be removed for cause, after hearing, in accordance with the provisions of section forty-one of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the city council of the city of New Bedford at a regularly scheduled city council meeting in the form of the following question: - "Shall an act passed by the general court in the year of nineteen hundred and eighty-one, entitled, 'An Act providing tenure of office for John J. McKenna, Jr., incumbent of the office of executive secretary of the traffic commission of the city of New Bedford', be accepted?" If two-thirds or more of the members of the city council vote in answer to said question in the affirmative, this act shall take effect, but not otherwise.

Chap. 382. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ABANDONMENT OF WATER SUPPLIES BY COMMUNITIES SUPPLIED BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.
