AN ACT TO PROVIDE HOSPITALIZATION AND TREATMENT  
FOR CERTAIN PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR ADMISSION TO,  
BUT WHO CANNOT BE ACCOMMODATED AT THE SOL-  
DIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Any person who is eligible for admission to and  
2 treatment at the soldiers' home in Massachusetts  
3 may be hospitalized and treated at any public or  
4 private hospital, provided that there are not sufficient  
5 facilities at the soldiers' home to care for such person.  
6 The cost of such hospitalization and treatment shall  
7 be paid by the commonwealth.
