AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTRIBUTIONS BY EMPLOYERS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (c) of section fourteen of chapter one
2 hundred and fifty-one A of the General Laws, inserted
3 by section one A of chapter five hundred and thirty-
4 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three,
5 is hereby further amended by inserting at the end the
6 following new paragraph:—

7 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this
8 subsection, the director may permit a corporation
9 which has succeeded to the business of an individual
10 or partnership, without substantial change in the
11 nature of the business, to continue the contribution
12 rate applicable to such predecessor individual or
13 partnership.
