Riley, Secretary and Treasurer of The New England Building Officials Conference, that a minimum salary be established for certain officials and inspectors in the employ of the Department of Public Safety and certain other inspectors in the building departments of cities and towns. AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM SALARY FOR CERTAIN OFFICIALS AND INSPECTORS IN THE EMPLOY OF THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, AND ALL INSPECTORS IN BUILDING DEPARTMENTS OF CITIES AND TOWNS OF OVER THIRTY THOUSAND INHABITANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salaries of all inspectors in build-
2 ing departments in cities and towns of over thirty
3 thousand inhabitants, throughout the commonwealth,
4 and in the Massachusetts department of public safety,
5 shall be equal to the average annual salary paid field
6 superintendents in charge of building construction.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
