By Mr. Lobel of Boston, petition of Louis Lobel for an amendment of the law relative to the issuance of commutation tickets by railroad corporations. Transportation.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Five.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF COMMUTATION TICKETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and sixty of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding the following new sec-
3 tion:—

4 *Section 190A.* Every railroad corporation shall sell
5 a commutation ticket good for not more than twelve
6 rides between each station on its lines within fifty
7 miles of the station of issuance of said tickets. The
8 said tickets, before issuance, shall be subject to ap-
9 proval by the department both as to rate of fare and
10 conditions named therein. So far as is practicable,
11 the rates of fare on all roads for like distances from
12 their terminal stations shall be equal.
