### RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF LILLIAN A. WILLIAMS AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Lillian A. Williams of  
2 Somerville, as a notary public between June twenty-  
3 first, nineteen hundred and forty-two and August  
4 eighteenth, nineteen hundred and forty-four, both  
5 dates inclusive, in so far as the same may have been  
6 invalid by reason of the fact that, upon the change of  
7 her name from Lillian A. Ranaghan, she failed to  
8 re-register under her new name and pay to the state  
9 secretary a fee of one dollar as required by section  
10 thirteen of chapter thirty of the General Laws, are  
11 hereby confirmed and made valid.
